**Scope:** Supports the delivery of enterprise program management, governance modernization, and performance analytics for a \$20M federal cybersecurity portfolio. We support strategic planning, investment review coordination, and risk-based decision-making, while automating workflows and building executive dashboards to improve visibility, accountability, and operational efficiency.

**Outcome:** Transformed manual, fragmented reporting and governance processes into standardized and automated workflows reducing administrative reporting effort by approximately 30%. Improved data integrity strengthened executive decision-making through real-time performance dashboards, and generated sustained operational efficiencies across the portfolio.
